Appointing a Chief Constable,
Sanitary & Inward Officer in
for the Town of Perth

Whereas it is necessary to appoint a
Chief Constable, Sanitary Inspector, and
Inward Officer in and for the Town of Perth
to fill the vacancy caused through the resignation
of Morley D. White.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the
Town of Perth enact as follows.

That John R. Griffiths be and he is hereby
appointed Chief Constable, Sanitary Inspector
and Inward Officer in and for the Town
of Perth and he is hereby required to
discharge strictly the duties of said office
as same are laid down in By Law
No 725 of the Town of Perth or of any other
By Law to be passed by this or any other
succeeding Council of the Town.

That in consideration of the due & faithful
performance of all the duties pertaining to
said offices the said John Griffiths shall
be entitled to be paid the sum of £450⁰⁰
per annum in monthly instalments of
£37⁵⁰ each during the time he holds such
positions. to be computed from the 10th
day of April 1910. same to be paid by order
drawn on the Treasurer signed by the Mayor
or Clerk of the Town of Perth.

In addition to the said sum of £450⁰⁰ the
said John R. Griffiths shall be entitled to
two suits of suitable clothing per year
same to be furnished by the Town and
all the fees including County fees coming
to him through the exercise of his office

shall make collection of mail from
the ^{usual} letter boxes at 7 P.M. each night
delivered to the Post
office officials.
