



LOST AND FOUND ARTICLES

Lost or found items may be reported over the phone or in person.

You need to provide the call taker or dispatcher with your name, address, phone number and date of birth.

You need to advise the call taker of the location of the found or last known location of the lost article.

A full description of the lost or found item should be given to the call taker, including serial number, or known card numbers.

If the lost item is recovered you should notify police.

Below you will find numbers for all major card holders.

If a wallet or purse is missing, you should immediately cancel all cards and notify your bank, if bank cards are included.

If a vehicle licence plate is lost or stolen you must attend the Ministry of Transport office and obtain a Replacement Declaration Form. This form must be brought to the police office. You must know if it is a trailer plate, vehicle plate, or a validated plate. The form is stamped and signed by a police employee and you must then return the form to the Ministry of Transportation to get new plates. The very same procedure is followed if you have a missing handicap sticker or plate.
