



Personal Safety While Shopping

Try to shop with a friend or relative.

Park your vehicle in a well-lit area. Put cellular telephones, walkmans or other valuables out of sight in your unattended vehicle.

Keep your vehicle doors locked and your windows shut, when you leave it unattended.

Know your surroundings. Keep an eye on the people in front of as well as behind you.

Carry your purse close to your body. Don't swing it loosely.

Don't display large amounts of cash.

Walk with confidence.

Approach your vehicle with your keys already in your hand.

Try not to carry too many packages. Place all packages out of sight in your vehicle, preferably in the trunk, when you leave it unattended.

If you see anything suspicious or if something just doesn't feel right, leave immediately and contact security or the police.

Remember: Simple precautions can reduce the risk of crime, but even the most alert and cautious person can still end up a victim. If you do become a victim of crime, call the police immediately - the sooner you report the crime, the better.
